Seeing these animals return to their families happy and healthy is what motivates us at work each day, pandemic or not.

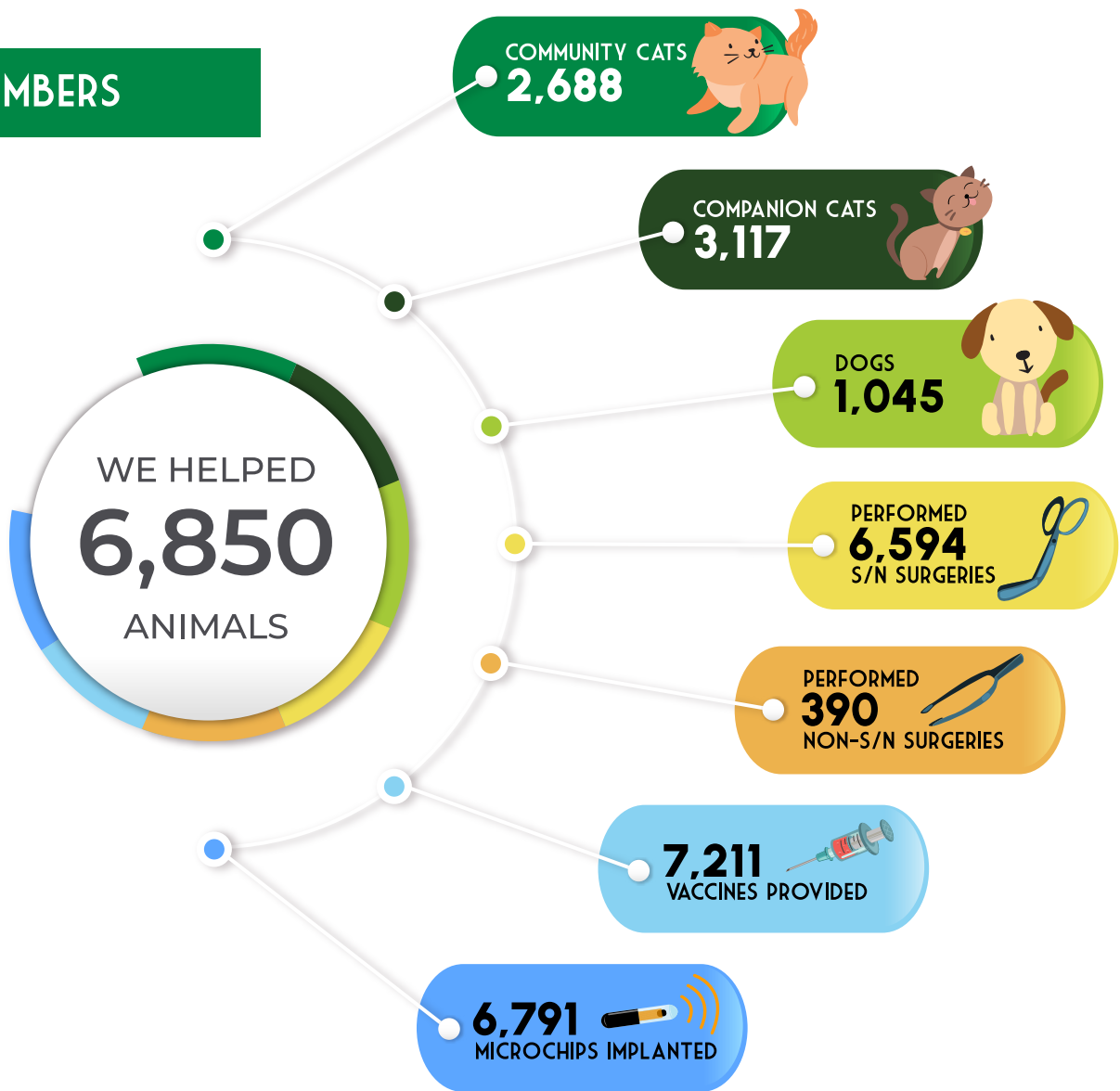

It is my privilege to be able to come to the clinic every day, and do the work that has such a positive impact on our community.

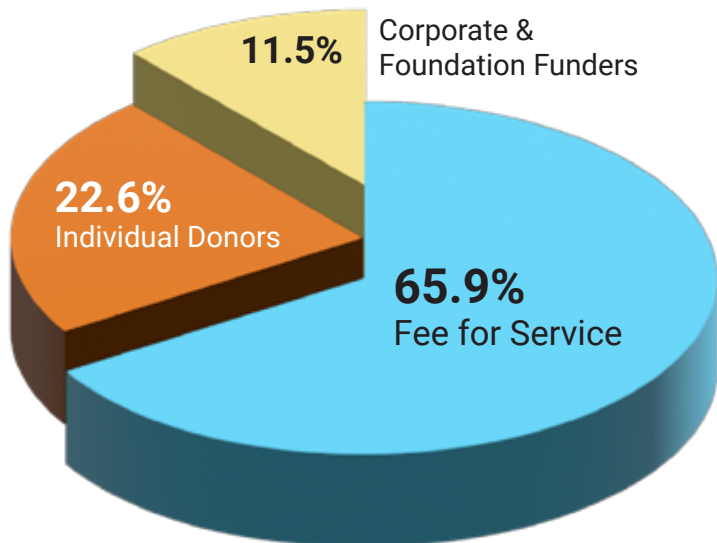

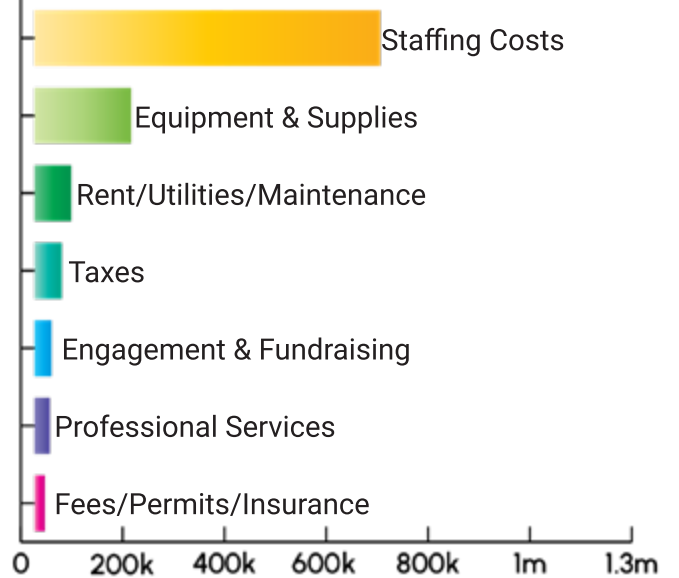
